PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

NAPLAN begins tomorrow for our Year 3 and 5 students. The National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is a nationwide measure. NAPLAN is made up of tests in the four areas of Reading, Writing, Language Conventions (Spelling, Grammar Punctuation) and Numeracy. The tests provide the school with information about how education approaches are working, and the areas to be prioritised for improvement. The results can assist teachers by providing additional information to support their professional judgement about students' levels of literacy and numeracy attainment and progress. NAPLAN is one of many measures that are used by your child's teacher to measure their learning progress. It should not be a stressful time for any student. All we want is for students to try their best.

COVID continues to affect our school on a daily basis. Reports of COVID cases across all stages of the school are currently present, in both students and staff. Whilst close contact rules have changed and if students and staff are symptom free, and regularly RAT test negative, they are able to attend school, we ask for your cooperation in ensuring that anyone exhibiting flu-like symptoms remain at home.

Thank you to the P&C for organising such wonderful events last week to mark Mothers' Day. The Mothers' Day stall on Thursday was a flurry of excited activity as students came out from class to select a special gift for their special mum, grandma, aunt. OFFICE REPORT

STUDENT ABSENCES

There have recently been a few questions raised in reference to students being coded *Unjustified* in Compass for late arrivals or early departures from school. Please refer to the below extract from Mrs Ward's Principal's Report from Term 1 Week 9:

"Parents or carers of children of compulsory school age are responsible for ensuring their child attends school every day. Children must commence school by age 6 and then complete year 10. Parents must also ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. **Justified** reasons for student absences may include:

- · being sick or having an infectious disease
- · having an unavoidable specialist medical appointment
- · being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral.

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unjustified on the student's record. Absences, whether full day or partial, can also be marked as unjustified if the reason provided does not meet the reasons outlined above."
