#### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

I was thrilled to see how well we were able to run it on the school site. I envisage moving forward that this will be repeated. At this point I would like to acknowledge the strong team of teachers who worked very hard behind the scenes to ensure the success of this event. There were many meetings and many more emails to ensure that everything ran smoothly. Dance items that go for 3-4 minutes take a lot longer than that to come into effect.
