## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Welcome back to Term 3. It is hard to believe that we are already halfway through the year. A busy term lays ahead of us once more.

COVID remains ever present in our schools. The department has updated its policy regarding COVID-19 vaccination for employees following an independent risk assessment of school (and corporate) settings and consultation with unions and relevant stakeholders. While vaccination will no longer be a requirement for our staff from 1 August 2022, the Department continues to strongly encourage all our staff to keep up to date with their COVID-19 vaccinations as a way of protecting themselves, students, and our school community.

Cleaning at school remains a high priority, with an increase in cleaning in school hours and a subsequent reduction out of hours. Day cleaning will continue to focus on high touch areas and other hard surfaces, door handles, light switches and handrails in stairways and movement areas.

Mask wearing is strongly encouraged for at least the first four weeks of Term 3, particularly in indoor settings or when distancing is not possible. The latest NSW Health advice also recommends wearing a mask for people who have recovered from COVID-19 and recently completed their 7-day isolation period for an additional 3 days (from days 8 to 10 after receiving a positive COVID-19 result).

The department will send another round of RATs to our school early this term, which we will provide to families in the form of 1 multipack of 5 RAT kits per student. These RATs can be used as required. Once these department-supplied RATs are exhausted, please continue to access store-purchased RATs which are now readily available in the community or PCR tests. Positive RAT results must be registered with ServiceNSW, and students who test positive to COVID-19 must not attend school until their isolation period ends and they are symptom free.

Ventilation remains a priority, and teachers are working to maximise natural ventilation whilst balancing thermal comfort. A reminder that any students displaying flu like symptoms will be sent home and parents are asked to keep students at home until they are well again. I understand the pressure that this places on families, however it is important that we continue to remain vigilant, particularly during these colder months. It is hard to believe that 12 months ago we were in lockdown. As we learn to live with COVID in our community it is important that everyone does their bit to get through this time.

We are currently experiencing a significant shortage of casual teaching staff. As our teachers become ill, it is quite likely that classes will be split. Whilst everything will be done to prevent this happening, at times it will be unavoidable.

During the holidays I know several families took the opportunity to come to school and use the grounds utilising the Share our Space Program. The NSW Government is keen to know what you think about using our school through their <a href="ONLINE FEEDBACK">ONLINE FEEDBACK</a> form. Now that the program is complete, if you would like to provide some feedback, please do so, following the above link.

Welcome back to Term 3. I trust everyone had some opportunity to rest and revive.



COMPASS makes it easy to send an attendance note for an unexplained whole day absence. Please follow the steps below:

## **ENTER STUDENT ABSENCE**

**OPTION ONE** 

Tap on student's photo. At the top of the page select approvals Go to the bottom of the phone and tap on plus sign located in the blue circle





## **OPTION TWO**

Go to the bottom of the phone and tap on 3 lines (more) Tap on *open* in browser Tap on Add attendance note

You will now be able to enter student absence/reason.

## SEND AN EMAIL TO YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER

Go to the bottom of the phone and tap on 3 lines (*more*) Tap on open in browser Tap on send an email You will now be able to email teacher

NB. The teacher's reply will go through to your email and not through the Compass app.

ie. You will need to open your emails in your browser.

Just a reminder to only record WHOLE Day absences on the Compass portal. The office will record partial absences upon the student's arrival or departure.
