PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

This term we start to make plans for next year. Each year parents approach the school with requests. To ensure transparency right from the start I have decided upon certain conditions for a parents' request to be considered. Firstly, I will not consider any requests for students in regard to placement in a composite class. All students in the school will experience both single year/grade and composite classes during their seven years at Boronia Park PS. Effective and high quality learning programs and activities are taught in all classes. Every classroom teacher differentiates programs teaching reading, writing and number to satisfy the learning needs of the student.

In addition, I will also not consider any requests for students to be placed with particular friends or teachers. This includes students starting kindergarten in 2023. Students benefit from being in classes with different students each year. They may be disappointed in the first few days, but they will make new friendships when faced with a different set of peers in their new class. This experience helps build personal resilience, a necessary trait for children as they grow up.

I would also like to reassure parents that often, when parents approach the school with their concerns, teachers are already aware of these matters and are already dealing with them in a sensitive manner. The teachers work very hard to organise classes and are aware of students who need to be placed apart from each other.

As requested last week, if you know that your child will not be returning to Boronia Park next year, I would appreciate you notifying the school as soon as possible. This will help us with our planning.

The first of our Year 4 groups attended Earthkeepers camp last week. Thankfully the rain stayed away and the children all enjoyed a wonderful time away. The second group head off tomorrow. Thank you to Mrs Butler who attended camp last week, Miss Tracey, who will be attending this week, and Miss Scott who is attending both camps to ensure that this camp can take place. I appreciate these teachers' commitment to our students. Good luck to our five students heading off to State Athletics this Wednesday/Thursday at Sydney Olympic Park. Ben G. will be competing in the high jump, Jack S will be competing in shot put, and then Jack will also compete with Stanley H, Alex E, and Louie B in the Junior boys relay team. To achieve this level of competition is an outstanding feat and I look forward to sharing their results with you next week.

DEPUTY PRINCIPAL'S REPORT
