PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

The school will be holding a short Remembrance Day ceremony this Friday at 10:50am. This ceremony will acknowledge the signing of the Armistice at the end of World War 1. This happened 104 years ago. The students and staff will observe a minute silence at approximately 11:00am in recognition of the many people who have lost their lives in support of our country and our democratic values during war and peace keeping operations.

Our first Kindergarten Orientation Day went very smoothly last week. It is always so impressive to watch the confidence of our new students as they enter the gates. Many of our new Kindergarten students for 2023 have older siblings at Boronia Park PS, so they are already familiar with the layout of the school. Those new students who are the first in their family to enter the school, however, are also so confident. I am looking forward to our second day tomorrow.

A reminder again regarding students in school uniform. It is important that the proper uniform is worn to school each day. This includes the school hat and not a sports or logoed cap. Black shoes with navy socks are also expected. I have noted several coloured joggers entering our school grounds which do bring down the tone of our uniform.

A reminder also that students should not be wearing some types of jewellery to school. Necklaces, bracelets and dangly earrings are not part of the school uniform and can all pose a safety risk if they are worn. These items can cause injuries for students when playing at recess, lunch or in sport activities.

Last week I handed out blank cardboard sheets to several cars in DOZO not displaying their child's name at pickup. If any further parents require a sheet of cardboard, please let the office know and we can supply a page. Clearly displaying your sign for DOZO really does make it flow so much smoother. Your cooperation in displaying a sign is most appreciated.

SELECTIVE HIGH SCHOOL - EOI NOTE

Selective high schools cater for academically gifted students with high potential who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic standard. Selective high schools help these students to learn by grouping them with students of similar ability, and by using specialised teaching methods. If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2024, you need to apply on the internet at: https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7.

Applications opened on 18 October 2022 and will close on 16 November 2022. You must apply **before** the closing date. You must submit only **ONE** application for each student. An expression of interest and notification via Compass were sent home on the Monday of week 2 and needs to be returned to your child's teacher if you intend to apply for the Selective High School test.
