PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Thank you to all the class parents who attended our forum last Tuesday afternoon. A very constructive conversation took place where the positives and challenges of the role were thoroughly discussed. I was thrilled with the responses provided and will be proactively working to bring about some of the suggestions provided so that we can ensure that the role is maximised to its full potential, without being too onerous for anyone.

Last Friday night's End of Year Family Picnic was a massive success. I was pleased to see so many families in attendance. The school choir kicked off the evening beautifully with some lovely songs, and our parent band, The Hunters Hill Collectors, were a massive hit. Congratulations to the P&C for organising such a successful evening and thank you to everyone who attended. I hope you all had a fabulous night.

This Wednesday night, 7 December, there will be two important presentations for parents of students in Kindergarten and Year 2. The presentations will focus on the transition, firstly for Kindergarten students moving to Year 1 (from 6:00pm to 6:30pm), and then for Year 2 students moving to Year 3 (from 6:30pm - 7:30pm). For both these grades, they will experience a significant change in expectations and operations in the new year, and the purpose of the evening is to explain this to parents. For Kindergarten parents the focus is on changes to homework, and the higher expectations for independence in Year 1. For the Year 2 to Year 3 presentation, the focus is also on the increase in expectations. As students move from infants to primary, presenters will discuss how class sizes increase, and provide an explanation of how selection of PSSA teams

takes place. Both sessions will be presented via zoom and links were sent home last week.

Reports will go out to students next Tuesday, 13 December. Teachers have been working this term, reflecting upon student performance and effort, to give a clear reflection of your child's progress. Due to some issues with the new reports, I must bring to parents' attention that this semester effort will be graded between 1 and 4, with 1 being minimal effort, through to 4 being maximum effort. For previous reports, the scale was 1 to 5. This change was not a school-based decision and I apologise for any confusion it may cause students and parents. Also, this will be the last time that reports will be printed for students. Moving forward, all student reports will be sent electronically, starting with the Semester 1 reports in June, 2023.

As the year comes to an end, some important notes regarding staffing changes. I would like to acknowledge and thank Mrs Taylor for her efforts as Relieving Deputy Principal. Next year, Miss Tracey will be stepping into this role. Miss Scott will be Relieving Assistant Principal in 2023. Mr Pasternatsky is moving to St Pats in Strathfield, Miss Kilmore to Meadowbank Public School, Miss Azara is moving to central NSW to Bingara Central School, and Miss Cappadona is moving south to be with her family. I would like to acknowledge all these teachers for their contributions to our school over recent years. They will be sadly missed, and I wish them all the best in their future careers.


