Road safety at the Drop off Zone (DOZO) at Boronia Park Public School

Key road safety messages:

- Students **MUST** be able to undo and do up their own seatbelt independently.
- Parents <u>MUST STAY</u> in the vehicle at all times
- In the morning say your goodbyes and have all belongings ready to go by the time you pull up in DOZO.
- In the afternoon, if students have not arrived at DOZO, parents will be asked to drive around the block




We want all our students to arrive safely to school and leave safely in the afternoon.

What is DOZO?

DOZO- Drop off Zone

DOZO is the School Drop Off Zone, where parents can drop or pick up students before and after school.

Students **must** exit the car on the school side of the car, **NOT** the traffic side.

Where is it?

DOZO is located on Earl Street.


Earl Street





When dropping off in the morning

- Cars pull into the drop off zone filling the space up to, but not covering, the driveway of 24 Earl Street, or behind cars already stopped.
- Parents and carers need to ensure students have all their belongings with them and goodbyes have been said so that students are ready to exit the car immediately after it stops.
- Students must be able to collect their own bag and shut the car door as they exit.
- Parents must always remain in the car.
- Students enter the school through the Earl Street gates.



When picking up in the afternoon

- Students will wait with teaching staff at the DOZO gate.
- Parents wait in the car in the DOZO line, moving their car forward as the line progresses. Parent must ensure their family name is on display in clear writing in the front window.
- Teaching staff will call out the name displayed on car dashboard.
- If the child is not at DOZO, parents/carers must move on and reenter at the end of the DOZO line.
- Students will be escorted to the front 2 cars. Staff will open the rear passenger side car door for students.
- Students are responsible for fastening their own seatbelts.
- Staff will pass student bags through the front passenger window whilst students buckle up.
- Car safely exits DOZO. <u>Do not</u> pull out before car in the front leaves.
