Each of the following activities will be 3 paragraphs - write a summary about the chapter, make personal connections to the book, describe the characters in the book, make predictions about what you think will happen in the story and write a book review recommending or things you didn't like about the story. Write questions about the book (Who? What? Where? When? How? Draw a picture of the main character or event, design a book cover. Try typing these activities on Word or on Google Docs and share it with your teacher.
- Spelling words continue homework activities.
- Maths mental – at least 1 unit per week
- Maths problem solving – Matharoo
- Maths textbook - pages 10, 16, 17, 18, 19 & Measurement - pages 104 & 106
- Grammar - pages 22 & 23
- Handwriting - pages 20 & 21
- Write a persuasive text about a topic that is of interest to you
- Use your imagination and write a narrative on any topic you like. Remember to include a sizzling start and to ban the boring.
- Complete the homework tasks that you didn't finish.
- STEM activity: design, draw and hypothesise how you would construct a bridge (approx. L=20cm, H=10 cm & W=5cm) using recycled materials from home. Try putting some weights and see if it can support the weight). Draw the finished bridge and write a review about your experience.
