- ❖ **Phonics:**
- ❖ Single sounds already taught in term 1:

satpinmnbdefuiobcgklru

single sounds to learn in week 9: l, v, k

single sound to learn in week 10: r, h, j

single sounds to learn in week 11: w, z, x

- ❖ Activities to help revise single sounds: say and write the single sound, write a list of words to go with a given single sound, make a poster showing your favourite single sounds using pictures and words, find the sounds in books
- ❖ Write all the letters of the alphabet in upper and lower case
- ❖ Draw a picture of something that starts with a given sound.
- ❖ Make the single sound using objects found at home.
- ❖ Blend some single sounds together eg: a- t at, o – t ot,
- ❖ Make some CVC words eg: c-a-t cat, p-o-t pot
- ❖ **Sight words:**
- ❖ The first 100 most frequent sight words are attached to this email.
- ❖ Revise known sight words.
- ❖ Choose 2 or 3 words to learn each day.
- ❖ Read and write the sight words you have chosen to learn.
- ❖ Find the sight words in books.
- ❖ Write the sight words into a sentence.
- ❖ **Writing:**
- ❖ Write a sentence or more each day.
- ❖ Here are some sentence starters to help you:
- ❖ *I went to...*
- ❖ *On the weekend I*
- ❖ *I saw*
- ❖ *Look at the*
- ❖ *Here is a*
- ❖ Write about your family. Draw a matching picture.
- ❖ Remember to reread and check your writing:
- ❖ Remember to *use a full stop, spaces between words, stretch out the sounds you can hear*
- ❖ **Maths:**
- ❖ Count forwards and backwards each day.

- ❖ Write numbers 1-30 and beyond if you can. Check your numbers to make sure they are written correctly.
 - ❖ Count on and back from a given number eg: start from 5 and count forwards 5,6,7,8,9
 - ❖ Before and after – give the number before and after for a given number. Eg: the number after 6 is 7 and the number before 6 is 5.
 - ❖ Roll a dice and write the number. Collect a number of objects to match the dice.
 - ❖ Revise teen numbers – a teen number starts with a 1. Write and make the teen numbers.
 - ❖ Patterns – make patterns using objects found at home, draw patterns using shapes or colours.
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- ❖ **Reading** – read a book each day or listen to a story being read to you. What happened in the story? Draw a picture or write about the story.
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- ❖ Do some fitness each day such as skipping or just dance or go noodle
 - ❖ Play a board or card game with someone in your family
 - ❖ Help your parents with jobs around the house – make your bed, clean your room, sweep the floor
 - ❖ Do some art using materials in your home, then take a photo.
