PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

It has been a wonderful start to the year. All students are in their 2023 classes and Kindergarten settled in well to their first week of school. I am so impressed with how quickly many of our Kindy students have adapted to their new environment. I would like to particularly acknowledge and thank our Kindergarten teachers, Miss Scott (Rel. Early Stage 1 AP), Mrs Parr and Miss Rawnsley, who have done a wonderful job in welcoming our newest school students.

I do ask for the school community's support in ensuring that from 9:20am through to 3:10pm, all gate entries remain closed. Gates will be open in the morning before school, however at 9:30am the Pittwater Road gate will be shut, and the Earl Street gate will be locked. After 9:30am the only access to the school will be via the Pittwater Road gates. Any parents entering school grounds during school hours are asked to ensure that the gate is closed behind them and that they present to the front office to check in. This is very important for the safety of all our students, and I thank you for your understanding in this matter.

Tonight, is *Meet the Teacher* night. This is such a valuable meeting for both teacher and parent. I urge all parents to prioritise your attendance at these meetings. Teachers will provide an overview of how their classroom will operate and of the content that your child will be covering. This is not a time for one-on-one discussions with parents regarding individual students. Please make an alternate time to discuss your child regarding personal matters.

Tonight, is also the night where we hope to finalise our class parents. Class parents play a crucial role in disseminating information. It should not be an onerous task and can be shared to make the role

even less so. Thank you to those parents who have already volunteered. Please see your child's class teacher if you can help.

Straight after Meet the Teacher meetings, at 7:30pm tonight in the library will be the first P&C meeting for 2023. Boronia Park PS is very fortunate to have a very active P&C. This parent group work very hard arranging several activities throughout the year, that build community rapport. The P&C also fundraise significant funds to support our school and students. I urge all parents to come along and join the meeting this evening.

Today, parents in Year 2-6 should have received their child's permission note for the swimming carnival. All students in Year 3 to 6 are expected to attend. Only those students in Year 2, turning 8 this year, and with the ability to swim 50m unaided, can attend. Using our new platform, School Bytes, this will be the first time where parents can sign an online permission note, without the need for any paper copies. This will hopefully ease the administration burden for parents and teachers in organising this, and future events. If you have any questions, please contact the office. As the swimming carnival is next Monday, the turnaround time is quite short. Please complete the online form by this Thursday, 16 February and ensure you click on the link in the permission form to register your child for their swimming event.

Finally, a reminder that teachers do not begin morning duty until 8:50am. No student should be on school site before this time, unless they are attending Boronia Park Care Centre, as the playground is not supervised.
