Students at Boronia Park Public School (BPPS) benefit from an active and engaged parent and carer community and we strive to preserve and promote this partnership.

Just as we ask BPPS students to adhere to the school values of Friendship, Harmony, Cooperation and Respect, BPPS School Council and the P&C has devised a brief Code of Conduct for parents and carers.

I will;

- Act to ensure the safety and well-being of all children, not just my own
- Respect the privacy of all children and their families
- At all times seek to model behaviours that reflect the values of the school
- Deal with concerns or conflict in a manner consistent with the above
- Contribute to an environment that celebrates diversity and creates an inclusive community

These principles should be considered when you are driving your children to and from school, attending your child's sporting fixtures, considering use of class email lists, visiting school grounds for any reason, engaging with BPPS staff, volunteering at any school-related functions or any other engagement with the school and school community.

This Code of Conduct has been created by parents and is designed to support a safe and constructive environment for our children, families and staff as we continue to work together for the benefit of the school and our community.

It sits alongside the NSW Department of Education's *School Community Charter* which outlines the responsibilities of parents, carers, educators and school staff in NSW public schools to ensure our learning environments are collaborative, supportive and cohesive.
